




collection of cuneiforms and copies of them;

1 500 parchments, 12th-20th century;

collection of manuscript books in Latin, Church Slavonic, and Polish, 11th-19th centuries.;

collections of documents of national minorities - Jews, Karaites, Tatars;

67 incunabula, including two unique specimens;

over 600 paleotypes;

collection of old photographs;

collection of ephemera (proclamations, edicts, etc.);

collection of old periodicals relevant not only to the history of Lithuania, but also to surrounding countries.







Typical storage floor plan








