Responsible institution: the Cyprus Library. There is no contact e-mail, only phone numbers on the official web-page.

Although there was a lithography used for the state documentation during the Ottoman Period, the first printing house in Cyprus was established in Larnaca in 1878 and Nicosia in 1882. In accordance with the studies of Hüdöđlü, during the Ottoman Period in Cyprus “this printing house using lithography were under the control of government and was used to copy the official documents. The content of the bibliography consists mostly of printed material that has been deposited in the Cyprus Library as required by the Cyprus ISBN Centre, which operates in the Library. In a few isolated cases, books published abroad under the main subject of Cyprus, are included in the catalogue for the benefit of the researcher.

The Cyprus Library publishes the annual *Butletin of the Cyprus Bibliography*, which covers the output of the publishing industry in Cyprus for the each year.

Through this catalog you have the opportunity to search all Cypriot publications from 1980 until today.
