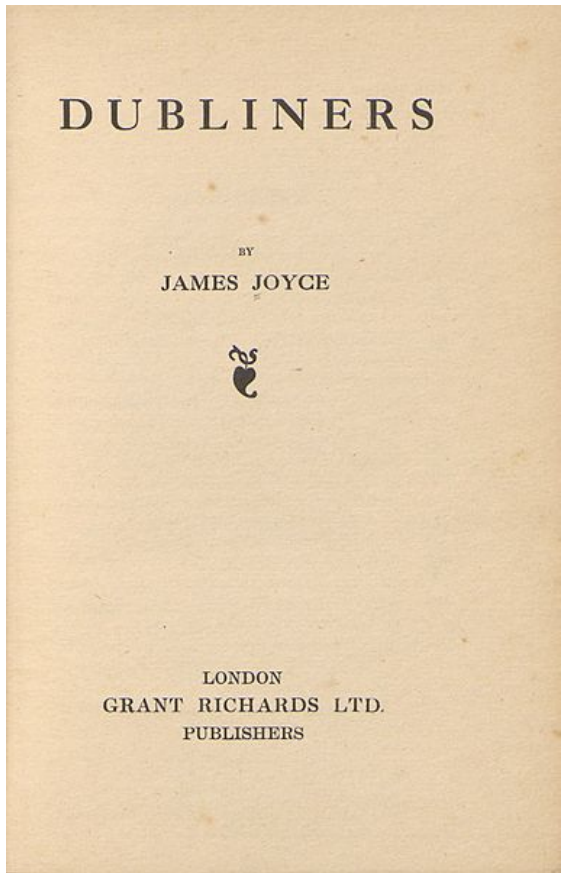

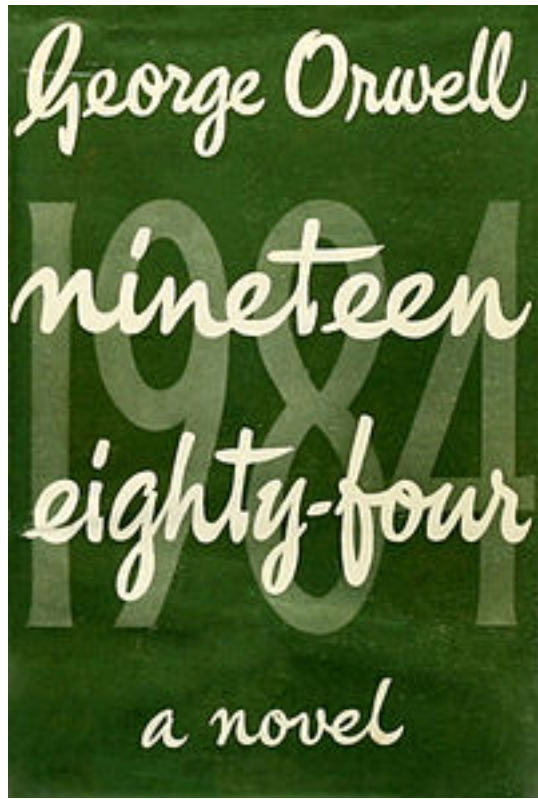
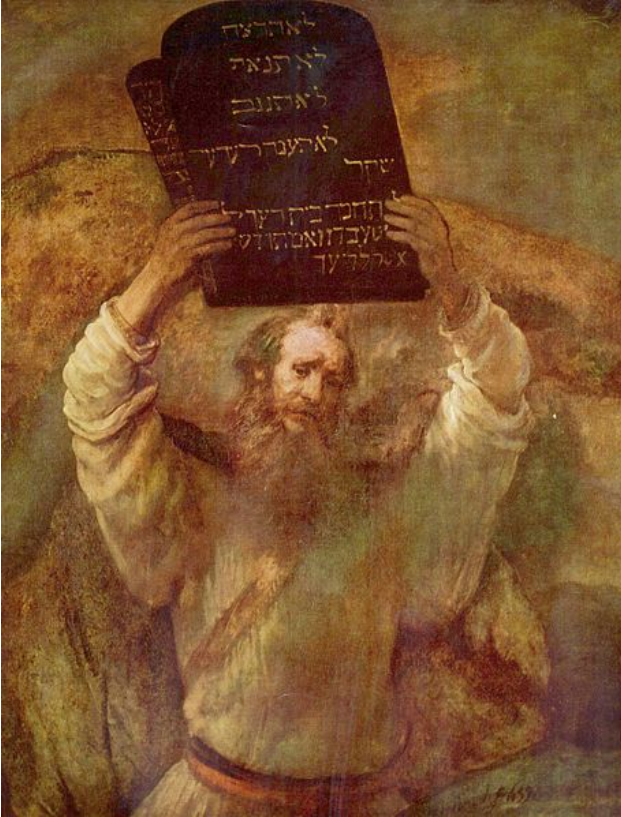

- No undermining of copyright exceptions
- No exclusivity
- BL owns digital assets created from physical collection items
- Time limited licence for a specific purpose
- Appropriate acknowledgement
